

WG S54 2019 CPR Timeline



- 2016 ○ Before becoming a teenager A was accommodated by the Local Authority
- 2017 ○ Care Order granted.
- September 2018 ○ A settled in a new placement but was unhappy living with other young persons and in conflict with other residents. A reports to be worried about their relationship with their mother, family time inconsistent.
- October 2018 ○ A visits mother's home outside of scheduled supervised 'family time' and utilises mobile phone and social media for unplanned family time.
- November 2018 ○ A reports not to wanting to spend time with mother. A reported to have a boyfriend.
- January 2019 ○ A reported to be struggling with school discipline and school uniform. A discussed at Permanency Panel – 'therapy' required urgently.
- March 2019 ○ A stays overnight at a friend's grandmother's home after spending 'family time' with her mother. A starts to truant from school and is reported as a missing person. A is reported missing 6 times from late March to late April.
- April 2019 ○ Concerns are raised that A's personal care has deteriorated. A reported as a missing person and located at her mother's home. In debrief A describes herself as stressed and just wanting a permanent home.
- Between 18th March 2019 & 25th April 2019 ○ A experiences 8 placement changes.
- 26th April 2019 ○ A is reported as a missing person. Missing episode lasts 6 days. A open to the police for 2 separate incidents; missing person and / or abduction. Incidents were not initially linked on police system.
- April 2019 ○ Children Services obtain Recovery Order, a S34.4 to suspend. Police issuing CAWN on adult of concern.
- May 2019 ○ A's mother may have been a victim of cuckooing. A made a number of disclosures to different professionals after being located. A volunteered that they had been in the company of adult male Y. They had observed knives being carried and witnessed violent incidents and the use and distribution of class A drugs. A was unsure initially if she had been serious sexually assaulted by an adult male X.
- June 2019 ○ Carers supporting A concerned that A was being threatened via A's mobile phone. A reports that Y is threatening. A discloses that during recent missing episode that they were sexually assaulted by two adults. A believed to have suffered trauma from missing episodes and A is reported to have self harmed. A seeks stability and reluctant to move to new placement. A wants to spend time with her mother.
- July 2019 ○ Ambulance called to placement as A experiencing a panic attack. A confirmed being contacted by adult X.
- September 2019 ○ A visited by police and social worker and it is explained that after a full investigation review there is insufficient evidence to progress to a prosecution. A reported missing with another resident from residential placement.
- October 2019 ○ Concern is raised that A is still being contacted by exploitative individuals.
